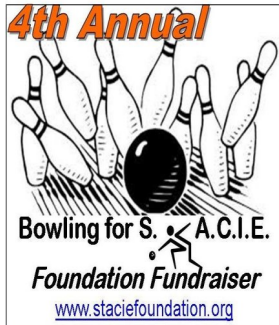

**National Crime Victim's Rights Week event at the Sharing H.O.P.E. Center was a huge success.**

The Sharing H.O.P.E. Center was selected as a recipient and awarded a grant due impart by the Ohio Attorney General's

Office, to bring NCVRW to the Sharing H.O.P.E. Center (SHC). SHC was selected from 209 applicants, included in 81 grants recipients, the only recipient of Ohio, in conjunction with 43 other states.

While in NC, she spoke at the

maximum security Women's Correctional Institute, which included death row inmates.

Lorraine presented at Aspire — Women's Group @ Hope Church in Mason, OH, last month.

It's been busy the last few months, yet a confirming testimony of all those God is touching through this

ministry.
